Pre-Stage ingredients according to formulas and the Plan of Power. Use white labels to ensure correct ingredients are staged according to process sheet. Document weights and lot numbers on formulas Fill out Melter Forms Daily Pull frozen ingredients out of freezer according to Thawing Process Change egg totes when empty. Assist Warehouse Receiver with moving pallets to make room for incoming ingredients. Maintain clean, safe and sanitary work areas.

This includes all dry ingredients areas (Ingredient Warehouse A, B, Icing Area and Tunnel Oven Area), Cooler A and B and the ingredient freezer area. Create warehouse transfer sheets twice daily (morning and afternoon). Use equipment (stacker and electric hand jack) properly and not abused. Contact supervisor when a problem arises. Communicate with next shift stagers with what is currently in process and what is coming up next.
