Sessions starting June 6 and August 2016**

Over the next 20 years, Peoples Gas will replace and upgrade more than 40 percent of their system. They need skilled workers.

The CFL Workers Assistance Committee, in partnership with People's Gas and the Utility Workers Military Assistance Program, is recruiting post 9/11 Veterans to be trained as Utility Line Workers. The program will provide the skills and knowledge needed to become successful in a career pathway within the Gas Utility Sector.



This is an intensive 7 month, advanced technical training program which includes a one month paid internship and mentorship with experienced journey-level gas utility workers.

Classes are for college credit and will be taught through Dawson Technical College, part of Chicago's Kennedy-King Community College.

You must attend an orientation session and submit an application to be considered.
Classes are limited to 25.
