COVID Contact Tracing Training Announcement

The training for the COVID-19 Contact Tracing program is now available on I-TRAIN. Any new staff hired under the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) grant for COVID-19 Contact Tracing is required to take this training. This training plan consists of two (2) separate training courses. You must complete both modules. The first module was developed by the Association of State and Territorial Health Officials (ASTHO) and the National Coalition of STD Directors (NCSD). The purpose is to provide rapid training to new contact tracers and focuses on building knowledge for remote contact tracing. Future training from ASTHO will include an additional module on field services.

The second module was developed by IDPH and includes information on disease surveillance in Illinois and how it relates to contact tracing.
