A career counseling session lasts approximately 30 minutes. The career counselor will review your education and experience as reported on your CMS-100 application and discuss state government employment opportunities with you that match your credentials and employment preferences with position titles for which you may be qualified and answer any questions you may have regarding examination procedures and eligibility requirements. If you are unable to make your appointment, please contact the assessment center in advance to cancel your appointment.
