The Program is responsible for the recruitment of well-qualified candidates for employment in underutilized categories for State employment through targeted outreach events and applicant counseling and is a resource for all State agencies, boards and commissions to supplement their recruiting efforts and develop strategies for diversification.

This position may require a current grade from Central Management Services (CMS), Division of Examining and Counseling, to be deemed qualified and available for employment consideration.
