Awards for Faculty (CFDA No. 45.160)

Purpose: To support individual faculty members at historically black colleges and universities, tribal colleges and universities, and Hispanic-serving institutions pursuing research of value to humanities scholars, students, or general audiences.

Eligibility: Individuals.

Funding: \$50,400.

Community Forest and Open Space Program (CFDA No. 10.689)

Purpose: To provide financial assistance to establish community forests that provide continuing and accessible community benefits.

Eligibility: Local governments, tribal governments, and nonprofits with jurisdiction over local land use decisions.

Funding: \$3.15 million.

Enhanced Collaborative Model to Combat Human Trafficking (CFDA No. 16.320)

Purpose: To combat all forms of trafficking—sex trafficking and labor trafficking of foreign nationals and U.S. citizens (male and female, adults and minors).

Eligibility: State, local, and tribal law enforcement agencies; and nonprofit victim service organizations.

Funding: \$500,000.

Enhanced Training and Services to End Violence Against and Abuse of Women Later in Life Program (CFDA No. 16.528)

Purpose: To provide or enhance training and services to address elder abuse, neglect, and exploitation,

including sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence, or stalking involving victims who are 50 years of age or older.

Eligibility: State, county, city, township, or special district governments; public and state controlled institutions of higher education; Native American tribal organizations; and nonprofits.

Funding: \$3 million.

Environmental Workforce Development and Job Training Grants (CFDA No. 66.815)

Purpose: To deliver environmental workforce development and job training programs that recruit, train, and place local, unemployed and under-employed residents with the skills needed to secure full-time employment in the environmental field with a focus on solid and hazardous waste remediation, environmental health and safety, and wastewater-related training.

Eligibility: State, county, city, township, or special district governments; private, public, and state controlled institutions of higher education; Native American tribal organizations; and nonprofits.
